Submission formatting

Paper submissions for NZOJIS should be 3000-6000 words in length, sent in Word file using Times New Roman font and with an accompanying covering letter stating the affiliation and contact details of the author. Please include a brief biographical statement. All papers should be referenced using APA style.
